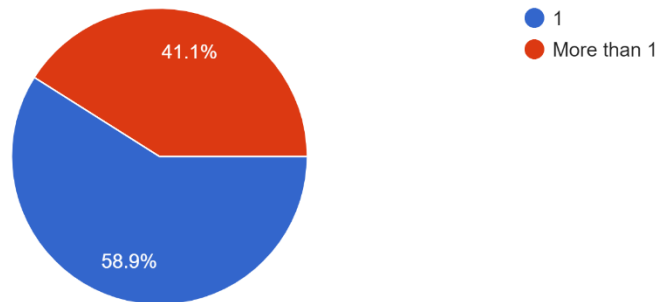

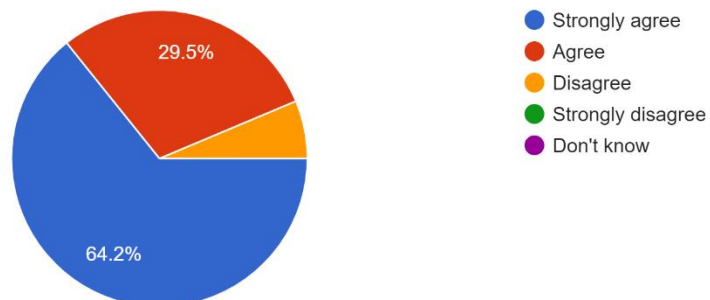
How many children do you have at Dickleburgh C of E Primary Academy?

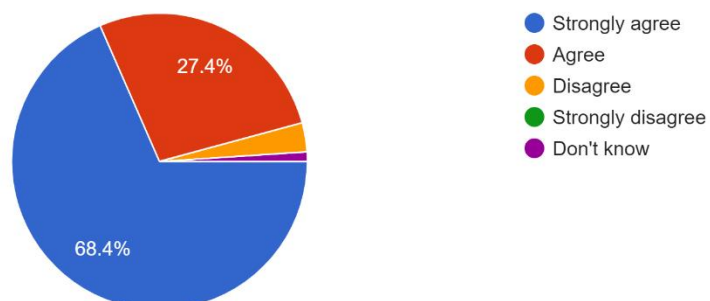
1) My child is happy at school.

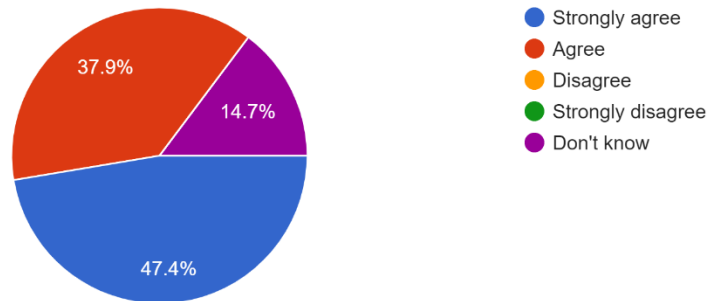
2) My child feels safe at school.

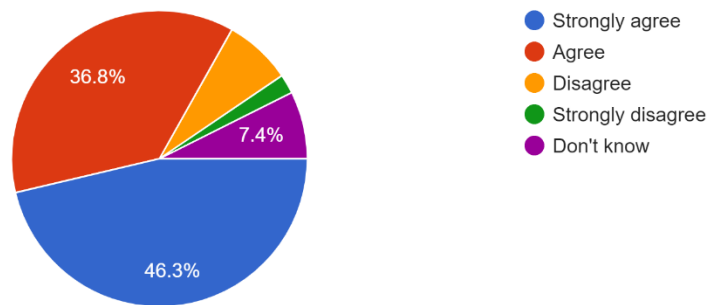
4) The school teaches my child how to keep themselves safe and deals sensibly with the risk (e.g. road safety, stranger danger, online safety etc.)

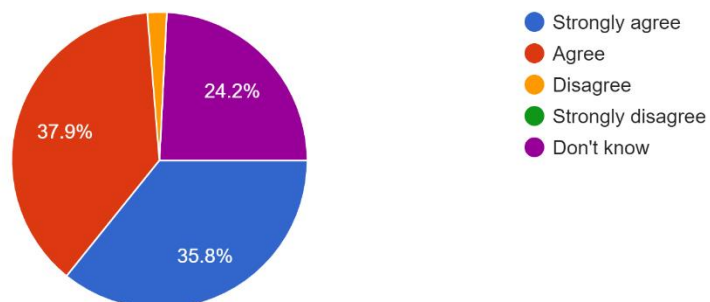
5) My child would feel confident about approaching a member of staff if they felt unsafe or unhappy in school

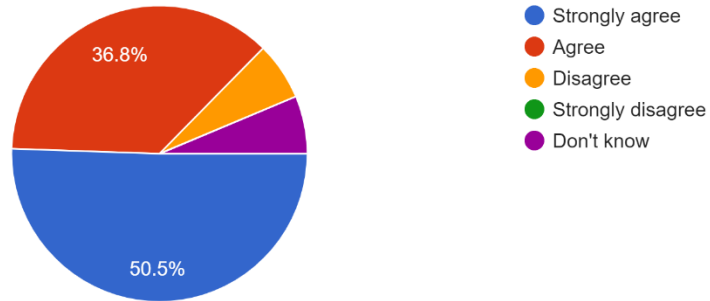
6) My child knows what to do in the event of a fire in school.

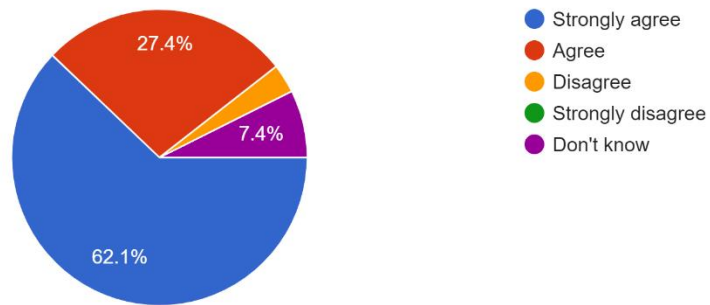
7) When my child is ill or injured the school acts promptly and appropriately to deal with the situation.

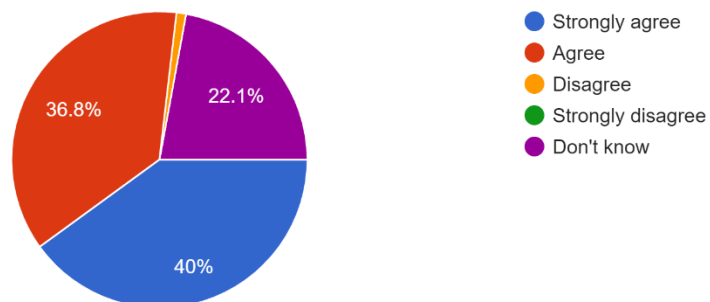
8) The school site is kept safe and clean.

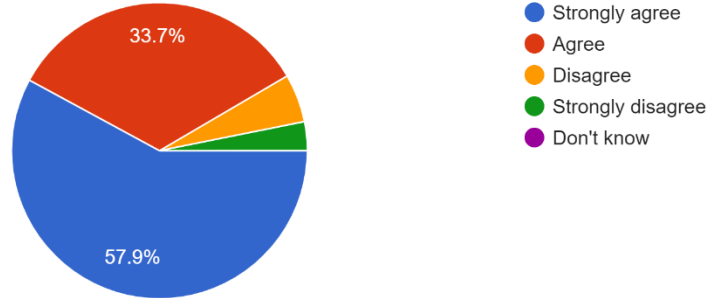
9) When my child is taken on a school visit, I am confident that the procedures in place keep my child safe.

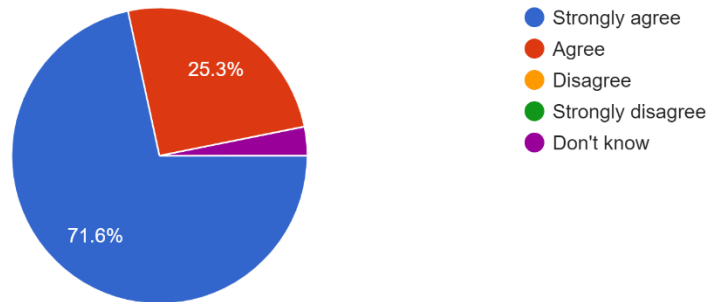
10) I feel confident and able to report any concerns or complaints to the school regarding my child's safety.

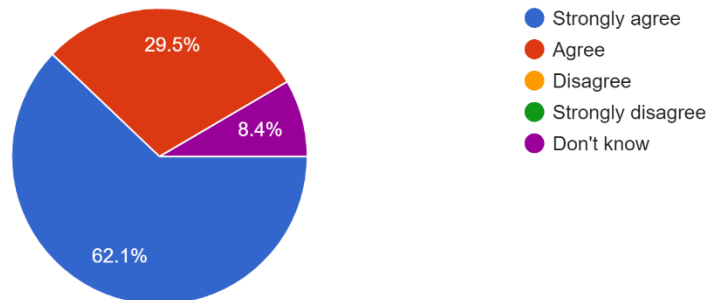
11) The school controls access to the school during the day, preventing any unauthorised adults getting into school.

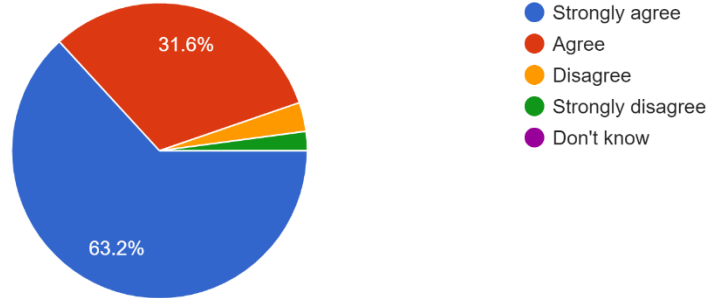
12) I feel confident that my child is safe at any of the clubs that are run before or after school.

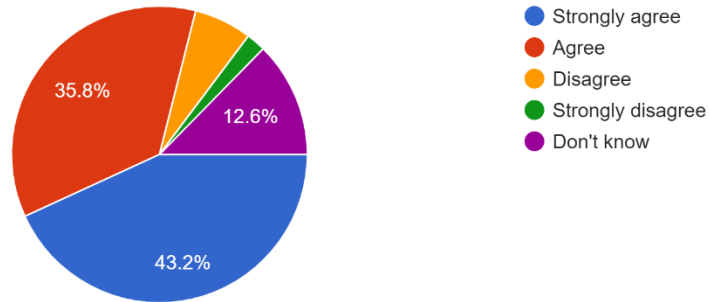
13) During COVID, the school kept me regularly informed of any changes or restrictions in place in school (e.g. newsletters, emails/texts, school Facebook page).
